



The Department of Education at the University of California, Santa Cruz (UCSC) invites applications for the position of Visiting Assistant Professor for the 2015-16 academic year, with the possibility of a one-year renewal. Outstanding candidates with experience in teaching in Education are encouraged to apply. Applicants should be able to contribute to the department's primary intellectual and practical focus of fostering equitable and effective schooling for all students. The successful candidate will be expected to pursue research, to have clearly demonstrated university teaching skills at the undergraduate level and provide service to the department. Possible related areas of research and teaching might include math, science, English, social science education, educational technology, English language development and literacy. There may also be possibilities for teaching at the Master's level in our MA/C program.

The Education Department has two vibrant minor tracks that serve more than 300 undergraduates each year, a model teacher-education program; and a growing doctor of philosophy (Ph.D.) program that attracts students who have exemplary preparation as well as experience working in educational settings.

RANK: Visiting Assistant Professor I-III

SALARY: \$57,600 - \$64,400, commensurate with qualifications and experience.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. or equivalent foreign degree in Education or a related field, expected to be conferred by September 2015. Demonstrated teaching experience at the university level.

POSITION AVAILABLE: July, 1, 2015 with academic year commencing Fall 2015. Appointments are contingent upon availability of funding. Ph.D. must be conferred by June 30, 2016 for employment beyond that date.

TERM OF APPOINTMENT: The initial appointment is for one year, with the possibility of extension. Should the hiring unit propose reappointment, a review to assess performance will be conducted. Reappointment is also contingent upon availability of funding.

TO APPLY: Applications are accepted via the UCSC Academic Recruit online system, and must include a letter of application outlining the applicant's interests and qualifications for the position, curriculum vitae, a teaching statement, and three reference letters*. Documents/materials must be submitted as PDF files.
