<p><b>Fall Enrollment for the MA/Credential Program</b>            Please see Multiple Subject and Single Subject Enrollment Instructions.  <i>*If you have not already done so, please make sure that you have enrolled in all of your MA Program fall classes prior to the Summer Bridge as the instructors would like to access their class rosters.</i> Follow all other fall quarter deadlines for graduate students (drop, add, swap and grade option) listed in the Academic and Administrative Calendar 2009-10.</p>	Opened Aug. 11 <sup>th</sup> .	
<p><b>School Placements</b>            Continue classroom observations: 10-15 hours in placement prior to Summer Bridge.</p>	Prior to Sept. 8 <sup>th</sup> , Observe 10-15 hours.	
<p><b>Summer Bridge</b>            Summer Bridge is an <b>early start</b> to a few of your fall classes (Beginning Student Teaching Seminar, Special Populations and Reading in Elementary Classrooms). <p><b>*Health Insurance Waiver: FALL 2009</b>            If you have your own health insurance and wish to continue to waive out of the UCSC Graduate Student Health Insurance Plan, you will also need to waive out for <b>Fall Quarter 2009</b> by <b>Sept. 17<sup>th</sup></b>. The Student Health Insurance Office will not accept waivers past the posted deadlines and does not accept waivers in paper format.
