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We are happy to learn that you will be joining the 2023-2024 Education MA/Credential program.

Please be aware that in order to start the credential program, admitted applicants must submit passing verification for the <u>California Basic Skills Requirement</u> and the <u>subject matter competency</u> requirement by June 10, 2023.

## <u>Subject Matter competency must be met with either option 1,2,3, or 4 below:</u>

Option 1: Subject Matter Program. For those who have completed a Commission-approved Subject Matter Program at a California college or university, please submit an official 100% Completion Letter signed by your institution's credential analyst by June 10, 2023. Please send an electronic copy of your letter to <a href="the MA/C Credential Analyst">the MA/C Credential Analyst</a>. Contact <a href="Esperanza Zamora">Esperanza Zamora</a> by <a href="May 1, 2023">May 1, 2023</a> if you will not be eligible to receive a completion letter from your undergraduate institution by the department's June 10 deadline.

**Option 2: Subject Matter competency met by passage of the CSET.** Verification of having passed all required CSET exams in your subject area. **Single Subject.** Passing verification for <u>CSET subtests</u> must be submitted to the UCSC Education department by June 10, 2023\*. Please submit required documents electronically by June 10, 2023 to <u>the MA/C Credential Analyst.</u>

**Multiple Subjects.** Passage of CSET Multiple Subjects subtests I-III (CSET test codes 101, 102 & 103) is required. Passing verification for the three Multiple Subjects subtests must be submitted to the UCSC Education Department by June 10, 2023\*. Submit required documents electronically by June 10, 2023 to <a href="mailto:the MA/C Credential Analyst">the MA/C Credential Analyst</a>.

**Option 3: Coursework.** Successful completion of coursework at one or more regionally accredited institutions of higher education that addresses <u>each of the domains</u> of the

subject matter requirements adopted by the commission in the content area of the credential. Please submit your unofficial transcripts and your completed <u>SMR Guidance form</u> to the <u>MA/C Credential Analyst</u> by April 17, 2023.

**Option 4: Academic major.** Successful completion of a baccalaureate or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education with the following degrees:

Single Subject degrees that meet the subject matter competency requirement:

- English credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
  - o English
- Math credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
  - Mathematics, applied mathematics
- Social Science credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
  - Social science
- Science credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
  - o Biology, human biology, marine biology, etc.
  - o Physics, applied physics
  - o Chemistry, applied chemistry
  - o Earth science, geoscience, earth and space science

For Multiple Subject candidates a degree in Liberal Studies and degrees that include any focus or concentration in the title. Examples include, but are not limited to, Liberal Studies: Urban Education, or Liberal Studies: Elementary Education.

\*Incoming students may qualify for an extension to the June 10 deadline to complete the CSET requirement if they have passed at least 1 of their required subtests. Extension requests must be received by the Department by June 10, 2023, and will need to include an electronic copy of an official Registration Confirmation for the next available CSET exam date and a copy of a score report verifying passage of at least 1 CSET subtest. To request an extension email Esperanza Zamora by June 1, 2023.

PLEASE NOTE: We are unable to offer extensions to the June 10, 2023 verification deadline for the CA Basic Skills Requirement. There are several options available to satisfy the Basic Skills Requirement. For further information please see this CTC guidance.

The Department is not able to defer admission to the Education MA/Credential Program. If you are unable to start the program in July due to unmet Basic Skills/Subject Matter Competence requirements, you will need to reapply to the program should you wish to attend in the future.
