Subject Matter competency must be met with either option 1,2,3, 4, or 5 below:

Option 1: Subject Matter Program. For those who have completed a Commission-approved Subject Matter Program at a California college or university, please submit an official 100% Completion Letter signed by your institution's credential analyst by June 10, 2023. Please send an electronic copy of your letter to the MA/C Credential Analyst. Contact [Esperanza Zamora](#) by **May 1**, if you will not be eligible to receive a completion letter from your undergraduate institution by the department's June 10 deadline.

Option 2: Subject Matter competency met by passage of the CSET. Verification of having passed all required CSET exams in your subject area.

Single Subject. Passing verification for [CSET subtests](#) must be submitted to the UCSC Education department by June 10*. Please submit required documents electronically by June 10, to the MA/C Credential Analyst.

Multiple Subjects. Passage of CSET Multiple Subjects subtests I-III (CSET test codes 101, 102 & 103) is required. Passing verification for the three Multiple Subjects subtests must be submitted to the UCSC Education Department by June 10*. Submit required documents electronically by June 10, to the MA/C Credential Analyst.

Option 3: Coursework. Successful completion of coursework at one or more regionally accredited institutions of higher education that addresses [each of the domains](#) of the subject matter requirements adopted by the commission in the content area of the credential. Please submit your unofficial transcripts and your completed [SMR Guidance form](#) to the MA/C Credential Analyst by April 17.

Option 4: Academic major. Successful completion of a baccalaureate or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education with the following degrees:

Multiple Subject candidates a degree in Liberal Studies and degrees that include any focus or concentration in the title. Examples include, but are not limited to, Liberal Studies: Urban Education, or Liberal Studies: Elementary Education.

Single Subject degrees that meet the subject matter competency requirement:

- English credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
 - English
- Math credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
 - Mathematics, applied mathematics
- Social Science credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
 - Social science
- Science credential, the SMR is met with an undergraduate degree in
 - Biology, human biology, marine biology, etc.
 - Physics, applied physics
 - Chemistry, applied chemistry
 - Earth science, geoscience, earth and space science

Option 4: Combination of coursework and CSET examination(s): some combination of coursework and CSET exams to meet the content for all required subtests.

*Incoming students may qualify for an extension to the June 10 deadline to complete the CSET requirement if they have passed at least 1 of their required subtests. Extension requests must be received by the Department by **May 1** and will need to include an electronic copy of an official Registration Confirmation for the next available CSET exam date **and** a copy of a score report verifying passage of at least 1 CSET subtest.
