<p><u>BASIC SKILLS REQUIREMENT</u></p> <p>Some students have not yet met the Basic Skills Requirement (BSR). Many of you met it previously with CBEST or high school SAT or AP tests. IF YOU HAVE NOT YET MET THIS REQUIREMENT, PLEASE MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO MEET WITH ESPERANZA.</p> <p>There is a new way to meet the BSR with college coursework in 3 areas with a grade of B- or better and 3 semester or 4 quarter credits: reading, writing, and mathematics. <i>If this does not apply to you</i>, and you have not yet met the BSR, then you must pass the CBEST by January 23, 2022. Please register now, complete the test by January 23rd, and provide results to Esperanza by January 28, 2022.</p> <p>Courses that meet the BSR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reading proficiency: a course in critical thinking, literature, philosophy, reading, rhetoric, or textual analysis. ● Writing proficiency: a course in composition, English, rhetoric, written communication, or writing. ● Mathematics proficiency: a course in algebra, geometry, mathematics, quantitative reasoning, or statistics. <p><u>SUBJECT MATTER COMPETENCY</u></p> <p>There is now an additional way to meet the Subject Matter Requirement by completion of an academic major in the subject for which you are seeking a credential.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Single Subject credentials, current options are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If BA/BS is in English, Math, Social Science, or Science (Biology, Physics, Chemistry, or Geology) then YES, you have met SUBJECT MATTER REQUIREMENT. ○ English degrees currently accepted <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ English ○ Math degrees currently accepted <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Mathematics, applied mathematics 		

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Social Science degrees currently accepted <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social science ○ Science degrees currently accepted <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Biology, human biology, marine biology, etc. ■ Physics, applied physics ■ Chemistry, applied chemistry ■ Earth science, geoscience, earth and space science ● For Multiple Subject credentials, the major must be in Liberal Studies or an interdisciplinary major that includes coursework in each of these areas: language studies, literature, mathematics, science, social studies, history, the arts, physical education, and human development. <p>Finally, it is possible that you may have met the subject matter requirement through coursework. We will email forms listing the specific course requirements by December 1.</p> <p>If you need to meet the Subject Matter Competency requirement with the CSET you must register now, complete the CSET tests by January 16, 2022, and provide passing results to Esperanza by February 4, 2022.</p>		
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State Credentialing Requirements

The following **state credentialing requirements** must be completed prior to application for the Preliminary Credential at the end of your second summer, **July 1, 2022**. The department's deadline to [submit verification of requirement completion to Credential Analyst, Esperanza Zamora](#), for your credential application is July 1, 2022. Students are encouraged to submit their verification documents upon completing their requirements throughout the year rather than waiting until the July 1 deadline.

<p><u>CSET LOTE Exam - (For Bilingual Candidates)</u></p> <p>To qualify for the Bilingual Authorization, in addition to completing courses ED 212A, 212B and 212C through the UCSC Credential Program, candidates must also verify passage of the CSET LOTE Spanish Subtests III & V.</p> <p>While the deadline to verify passage of the CSET LOTE Spanish Subtests III & V to the department for your credential application is July 1, 2022, there are limited opportunities to take CSET Spanish Subtest III throughout the year. <p>*<u>RICA Test Requirement (Multiple Subjects Only)</u></p> <p>Multiple subject candidates are required - prior to completion of the program and in order to be recommended for a credential - to pass the RICA exam. The RICA exam measures the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to offer effective reading instruction to K-12 students. The RICA exam may NOT be taken prior to completion of the required Multiple Subject Reading Instruction course (EDUC 220: Reading and Language Arts for Elementary Classrooms). RICA registration and test information (written test required) can be found here. <p><u>COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS IN PLACEMENT AND ON CAMPUS</u></p> <p><i>PLACEMENTS</i></p> <p>In your placement, you must check with your Cooperating Teacher and follow all protocols required by the school site and the district. Minimally, you must wear a face mask at all times when indoors at placement and sanitize your hands frequently.</p> <p><i>CAMPUS</i></p> <p>1) First, it is important that you set up Health e-Messenger by logging in with your CruzID and gold password.</p> <p>2) Second, <i>EACH DAY</i> that you attend class, before coming to campus, log into Health e-Messenger, and select "Complete Survey." This will generate a Clearance Badge. To see your badge, go to your Health e-Messenger home screen and select Show Badge. You may need to show this badge when you participate in UCSC activities like eating at dining halls, attending in-person classes, etc.</p> <p>3) Third, wear a face covering in all campus indoor spaces.</p> <p>4) Finally, and possibly most importantly, <i>do not come to class or campus if you are not well</i> or if your badge is not green. If you forget your mask, you can ask your instructor for one; there is a limited supply of disposable masks in each classroom. If you are ill or suspect you may have been exposed to someone who is ill, or if you have symptoms that are in any way similar to those of COVID-19, please err on the side of caution and stay home until you are well or have tested negative after an exposure. Let your instructor know that you are not feeling well.</p> <p>Below are the COVID safety protocols for returning to campus for class or any other purpose. These are currently in effect. The university has stated their intention to update the campus COVID-19 safety protocols.</p> <p>1. <u>Face coverings</u> UC Santa Cruz requires that everyone, regardless of vaccination status, wear a face covering when accessing shared campus indoor spaces.</p> <p>2. <u>Hand sanitizer</u> Wash with provided hand sanitizer when entering a scheduled class. Sanitizer will be available in MA/C classes.</p>	<p><i>Deadline to verify completion of all credentialing requirements</i> July 1, 2021</p>	

3. **Sanitizing wipes**

MA/C instructors will have sanitizing wipes available in classrooms. We encourage individuals to wipe down any surface that they will contact.

4. **Social distancing**

There are currently no social distancing requirements.

5. **Daily symptom check**

How it Works: You will receive a daily email and text reminder to track your symptoms using our online patient portal, [Health e-Messenger](#). With Health e-Messenger, you'll do daily symptom surveys, schedule COVID-19 tests (view [current testing locations](#)), and see your Clearance Badge.

Cost: On-campus tests are free to UCSC students, **including** those without UC SHIP. [Off-campus tests may have a cost](#) depending on your insurance.

Set up Health e-Messenger

You will receive a daily email reminder, and it is strongly recommended that you sign up for texts. Log into [Health e-Messenger](#) with your CruzID and gold password.

Once logged in:

- Go to **Medical Clearances**. Complete the Notice of Privacy Practices, General Consent, and Assignment of Benefits.
- Go to **Profile** in the left menu. Enter your Santa Cruz address and mobile phone number and carrier. You will now receive daily email and text reminders to track your symptoms.

Important: Using your myUCSC, let UCSC know of your new address immediately after arriving on campus or in Santa Cruz County. Make sure you use your Santa Cruz address, not your permanent address back home.

After you complete your daily symptom screening survey, Health e-Messenger **creates your Clearance Badge**.

To see the badge, go to your Health e-Messenger home screen and select **Show Badge**. You may need to show this badge when you participate in UCSC activities like eating at dining halls, attending in-person classes, etc.

Complete Immunization and Tuberculosis Risk Screening Compliance Process (Policies for COVID-19 and Flu Vaccines)

The University of California requires that all incoming students (including re-admitted and deferred admission students) complete an Immunization and Tuberculosis Risk Screening Compliance Process prior to arrival on campus.
