<p>Graduate Student Health Insurance Waiver</p> <p>All students are required to have health, dental and vision insurance. Students who already have their own health, dental and vision insurance and wish to waive out of the UCSC Graduate Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP) for Summer Quarter 2022 must complete an online waiver (found under “What to Do”) through the UCSC Health Insurance Office by July 4, 2022. Waiving out of UC SHIP is an online process. <p>Complete Immunization and Tuberculosis Risk Screening Compliance Process</p> <p>There are 3 separate immunization requirements for UC Affiliates:</p> <p>1) SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Vaccination Program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ This policy applies to all UC students, trainees, personnel and all others who work, live, and/or learn in any of the University’s locations or otherwise participate in person in University Programs. ■ Covered individuals are required, subject to limited deferrals, exceptions, and associated non-pharmaceutical interventions, to be fully vaccinated, including boosted (if booster eligible), against COVID-19 before physically accessing the University’s Locations and Programs. ■ There are limited exemptions for covered individuals. ■ Please visit COVID-19 Vaccines for more information. <p>2) Flu Vaccine Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The University of California issued an executive order on Oct. 8, 2021, requiring flu vaccination for all students, faculty, other academic appointees, and staff living, working, who will learn, live or work on-premises at a UC facility. ■ The requirements for Fall 2022 will be announced when they are confirmed. ■ For employees, please see the frequently asked questions about UC’s 2021-2022 flu vaccine executive order to learn more about UC’s policy. <p>3) University of California Immunization Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ This policy currently applies to all incoming students (undergraduates, graduates, transfers, and re-admits) who are living, studying, or coming to campus for any reason. ■ Covered individuals are required to show proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella (Chicken Pox), TdaP and Meningitis ACYW (for those under the age of 21) and screening for Tuberculosis (TB) risk ■ The University of California allows for exemptions to these immunization requirements based only on a medical condition 	<p>ASAP</p>

Please note: approved religious COVID-19 exemptions do not apply to the required vaccinations listed under the UC immunization policy</p> <p>Penalty for Non-Compliance</p> <p><i>If you are living, studying, or coming to campus for any reason and don't meet these requirements, you can't attend classes.</i> Please make these immunizations a high priority! Without them, an enrollment hold will be placed on your registration.</p> <p>Deadline</p> <p>The deadline for all required vaccines (except Flu) is before you come to campus. However, please consider the deadline to be "as soon as possible" so you don't risk enrollment holds.</p> <p>For more information, visit the Health Center website.</p> <p>Additionally, due to your placement in local schools, please take a photo of your COVID-19 vaccination card and upload it here asap if you have not done so already. We need to attest to local districts that you are fully vaccinated. Our partner districts require evidence of COVID-19 vaccines for candidates who are placed in their schools.</p>		
<p>Parking Permits</p> <p>If you are planning to park on campus during the summer session, please visit the UCSC Transportation and Parking Services (TAPS) website for information on parking permits for Graduate Students. Email tapsales@ucsc.edu if you have questions.</p> <p>We recommend that you purchase your parking permit on a quarterly basis, since your class schedule changes each quarter. Summer Quarter classes will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Fall Quarter is 3 to 4 days per week, depending upon your program, and your hours on campus will decrease during Winter and Spring Quarters as your student teaching hours increase in your placement.</p> <p>Please note: Parking regulations are strictly enforced on campus. You will need a parking permit to park on campus for the first day of class.</p> <p>We suggest that you carpool with classmates; you will find that you are on similar class schedules. Before committing to the expense of quarterly parking passes you may want to arrange shared transportation.</p>	Available Now	

Student ID Cards

MA/Credential students may obtain a Graduate Student ID Card from the [ID Card Services](#) Office (*located on the first floor of the Bay Tree Bookstore Building*) on the first day of classes, July 18. The office will be open from 10:00am - 3:00pm pick up by appointment.

A UCSC Student ID is issued to new students free of charge, with new students receiving their validation sticker (if all fees have been paid for). Continuing students will need to receive their validation stickers from their college office. The sticker will signify that you have paid all fees and are registered as a student. The college will be able to issue a sticker the business day after you have paid your fees at the Cashier's Office at the Student Business Services.

Your validated and stickered Student ID allows access to various campus offices and services which include; the library, health center, field house, dining halls, and all Santa Cruz Metro buses. Your Student ID is required by the Office of the Registrar for access to records and services. In the event your Student ID's magnetic strip no longer functions, please bring the card to ID Card Services to have it examined. To pick up your card you must bring your UCSC Student ID number and a government-issued photo ID with you.

For new students starting summer quarter:

- In June: If you are living on campus: at move-in or at the Porter College office. If you are living off-campus: at the ID Card Services Office after the first day of Session 1, 8-wk, 10-wk classes.
- In July: If you are living on campus: at move-in or at the Porter College office. If you are living off-campus: at the ID Card Services Office after the first day of Session 2 classes.
