<p>STATE CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>The following state credentialing requirements must be completed prior to application for the Preliminary Credential at the end of your second summer, July 2023. The department’s deadline to submit verification of requirement completion to Credential Analyst for your credential application is July 1, 2023. <p>RICA Test Requirement (Multiple Subjects Only)</p> <p>Multiple subjects candidates are required - prior to completion of the program in order to be recommended for a credential - to pass the RICA exam.</p> <p>The RICA exam measures the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to offer effective reading instruction to K-12 students. <p>Student ID Cards</p> <p>MA/Credential students may obtain a Graduate Student ID Card from the ID Card Services Office (<i>located on the first floor of the Bay Tree Bookstore Building</i>) on the first day of classes, July 18. The office will be open from 10:00am - 3:00pm..</p> <p>A UCSC Student ID is issued to new students free of charge, with new students receiving their validation sticker (if all fees have been paid for). After your first summer quarter, you will receive your quarterly validations stickers from your teacher supervisor or the instructor of your student teaching seminar classes (200, 201, 202). The sticker will signify that you have paid all fees and are registered as a student.</p> <p>Your validated and stickered Student ID allows access to various campus offices and services which include; the library, health center, field house, dining halls, and all Santa Cruz Metro buses. Your Student ID is required by the Office of the Registrar for access to records and services. In the event your Student ID's magnetic strip no longer functions, please bring the card to ID Card Services to have it examined. <p>CalFresh and Other Campus Resources for Food Security</p> <p>Below is information below about CalFresh and also about a number of other campus UCSC resources to increase student food security.</p> <p>While we are happy to say that the UCSC MA/C Program is an approved Cal Fresh Employee and Training Program, we are devastated and furious that Cal Fresh is not available to DACA, international and undocumented students. The university asks that if you have DACA, or are an international or undocumented student, that you contact Slug Support Case Management Program to find other means of getting food assistance (also see below).</p> <p>Graduate students in the MA/C program also must still meet CalFresh eligibility requirements (e.g. citizenship and income).
