<p>*<u>Mental Health First Aid Course - December 8</u></p> <p>Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is an 8-hour class being offered to UCSC MA Credential Students that will focus on youth ages 12-18. Participants learn a five-step action plan to help loved ones, colleagues, neighbors and others to cope with mental health problems. Participants that complete the class receive a three-year certification in MHFA.</p> <p>Mental Health First Aid is help provided to a person developing a mental health problem or experiencing a crisis until professional treatment is obtained or the crisis resolves.</p> <p>THIS CLASS IS SPECIFICALLY ORIENTED TO THE NEEDS OF YOUTH.</p> <p>We strongly urge you to attend this important class, however, it is optional. Otherwise, if you believe that you have completed a course that fulfills this requirement, contact Kim Jackson (kljacks@ucsc.edu) by Dec. 1st sending her a copy of your transcripts (may be unofficial) noting the course.</p> <p>All other students may fulfill the US Constitution Requirement through the Education Department test. There will be 4 more exams offered before you exit the program (2 exams will be offered during the winter & 2 exams will be offered during the spring). Exams will not be offered during the summer quarter.
