* Mental Health First Aid Course - December 8	December 8	
Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is an 8-hour class being offered to UCSC MA Credential Students that will focus on youth ages 12-18. Participants learn a five-step action plan to help loved ones, colleagues, neighbors and others to cope with mental health problems. Participants that complete the class receive a three-year		
certification in MHFA.		
Mental Health First Aid is help provided to a person developing a mental health problem or experiencing a crisis until professional treatment is obtained or the crisis resolves.
