RICA Test Requirement (Multiple Subjects Only) Multiple Subject candidates are required, prior to completion of the program and in order to be recommended for a credential, to pass the RICA Exam. The RICA Exam measures the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to offer effective reading instruction to K-12 students. The RICA Exam may NOT be taken prior to completion of the required Multiple Subject Reading Instruction course (EDUC 220: Reading and Language Arts for Elementary Classrooms).
