<p><b><u>RICA Test Requirement (Multiple Subjects Only)</u></b></p> <p>Multiple Subject candidates are required, prior to completion of the program and in order to be recommended for a credential, to pass the RICA Exam.</p> <p>The RICA Exam measures the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to offer effective reading instruction to K-12 students.
