*RICA Test Requirement (Multiple Subjects Only) Multiple subject candidates are required - prior to completion of the program and in order to be recommended for a credential - to pass the RICA exam. The RICA exam measures the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential to offer effective reading instruction to K-12 students. The RICA exam may NOT be taken prior to completion of the required Multiple Subject Reading Instruction course (EDUC 220: Reading and Language Arts for Elementary Classrooms). RICA registration and test information (written test required) can be found here. The exam fee is \$171. Deadline to verify passage of the RICA is July 1, 2019.
