Timeline

- Review: MA/C admissions requirements
- <u>December 4</u>: RSVP and attend the Meet the Districts Virtual Panel to learn about the residency partner districts
- December 5, 17, or January 8: Attend a MA/C application workshop
- February 3: <u>Application due to the UCSC MA/Credential program</u> (informal notification of admission in late February; official Graduate Division notification in early March)
- February 16: Apply to the Residency Program
- February 26: Required in-person, initial interviews; selected participants will be asked to schedule a subsequent district interview in March
- Early April: Residency applicants notified of offer
- April 15: Deadline to notify UCSC Graduate Division of your intent to register
