Timeline

- **Review:** [MA/C admissions requirements](#)
- **December 4:** **RSVP** and attend the *Meet the Districts Virtual Panel* to learn about the residency partner districts
- **December 5, 17, or January 8:** Attend a [MA/C application workshop](#)
- **February 3:** [Application due to the UCSC MA/Credential program](#) (informal notification of admission in late February; official Graduate Division notification in early March)
- **February 16:** [Apply to the Residency Program](#)
- **February 26:** Required in-person, initial interviews; selected participants will be asked to schedule a subsequent district interview in March
- **Early April:** Residency applicants notified of offer
- **April 15:** Deadline to notify UCSC Graduate Division of your intent to register

Qualifications

- Single Subject candidate in the UCSC MA/Credential Program
- **Priority** is given to applicants who
 - are local to the greater Santa Cruz area
 - are interested in teaching in the residency district
 - are bilingual (Spanish)
