the Seriousness of Abolition”**

Dr. Stovall's discussion chronicles his pathway through the academy, noting the numerous encounters of those involved in movement work or those who were interested more in personal capitalist gains. Throughout this process he strengthened his understanding of Critical Race Theory (CRT), intersectionality, and praxis. Upon being introduced to prison abolition, he has been challenged by the call of abolition to live and think differently. It is challenging work, but work that we cannot turn away from if we say we are serious about working with others to change our conditions.
